Housing & Homelessness

Many of us take our homes for granted. We work, we play, we tend to our families. At the end of the day, we go home to rest and refuel. Imagine if you did not have a place to call home. Imagine if you did not have a place to rest and refuel. That was the case for 1,403 people in the Mohawk Valley.

As the designated, lead agency to operate a Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) under the Continuum of Care (CoC) Program, the United Way of the Mohawk Valley acquires quality data to help prioritize service and assistance based on vulnerability and severity of service needs to ensure that people who need assistance can receive it in a timely manner. Because of this process, our Housing staff was able to serve 1,403 people who now have a place to call home where they can rest and refuel.

Veterans, youth, adults, and children sought the United Way of the Mohawk Valley for housing, and we acted.

Housing and Homelessness will continue to rise, and our needs will continue to grow. Together we can support our community's greatest need.

Empowering the Workforce

A resident of Herkimer county was unemployed for months due to lack of reliable transportation. When he secured an interview for a promising position, he worried about how he'd get there. With a Lyft ride provided though the Ride United program, he not only attended the interview because of Ride United, he landed the position! He said, "I've started my new role, and I can finally provide for my family again."

Breaking Barriers to Healthcare Access

A single mother in Oneida county faced a hardship when she had to choose between paying for transportation or skipping her child's much-needed Dr's appointment. Without a vehicle, and limited public transportation options, she was referred to United Way of the Mohawk Valley's Ride United program. Not only was her child able to attend her Dr's appointment for much-needed medical care, our client also discovered additional resources through our network. She said, "This program saved me from missing a critical appointment and gave me peace of mind."
