

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

CONNECTING PEOPLE. STRENGTHENING COMMUNITIES, CREATING LASTING CHANGE.

211 MIDYORK

211 MIDYORK REMAINED A TRUSTED LIFELINE FOR RESIDENTS ACROSS ONEIDA, HERKIMER, & MADISON COUNTIES, CONNECTING PEOPLE TO ESSENTIAL SERVICES AND SUPPORRT. IN 23–24, 3,580 CALLS WERE ANSWERED EACH REPRESENTING SOMEONE SEEKING HELP, HOPE, OR DIRECTION. THE TOP NEEDS IDENTIFIED WERE HOUSING, FOOD ASSISTANCE, AND LEGAL SERVICES.

RIDE UNITED TRANSPORTATION

TRANSPORTATION REMAINED ONE OF THE LARGEST BARRIERS TO ACCESSING WORK, HEALTHCARE, AND EDUCATION. THROUGH RIDE UNITED, RESIDENTS COMPLETED 824 RIDES ASSISTING WITH TRANSPORTATION TO ESSENTIAL NEEDS AND CRITICAL CARE. RIDE UNITED DEMONSTRATES THAT SOMETIMES, ONE RIDE CAN CHANGE EVERYTHING, A NEW JOB OPPORTUNITY, A DOCTOR'S APPOINTMENT KEPT, OR A FAMILY REUNITED WITH CRITICAL RESOURCES.

COORDINATED ENTRY

AS THE LEAD AGENCY FOR COORDINATED ENTRY, UWMV REFERRED 836 FAMILIES EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS OR HOUSING INSTABILITY WITH THE RIGHT SUPPORT AND RESOURCES. THIS SYSTEM BROUGHT TOGETHER LOCAL SHELTERS, HOUSING PROGRAMS, AND CASE MANAGEMENT SERVICES TO CREATE A UNIFIED APPROACH, REDUCING BARRIERS, ELIMINATING DUPLICATION, AND ENSURING PEOPLE IN CRISIS FOUND A SAFE PATH FORWARD. EVERY INDIVIDUAL REFERRED THROUGH CE REPRESENTS A STEP TOWARD HOSING STABILITY AND HOPE. UNITED WAYS LEADERSHIP CONTINUES TO STRENGTHEN COLLABORATION AMOUNG SERVICE PROVIDERS TO ADDRESS THE COMMUNITIES GROWING HOUSING CHALLENGES.

EMERGENCY FOOD & SHELTER

UWMV SERVES AS THE LEAD AGENCY FOR BOTH ONEIDA & HERKIMER COUNTIES UNDER THE GUIDANCE OF UNITED WAY WORLDWIDE IN COORDINATION WITH FEMA. AS THE LEAD AGENCY UWMV IS RESPONSIBLE FOR HOLDING TWO LOCAL EFSP BOARDS ONE REPRESENTING EACH COUNTRY, OVERSEEING THE DISTRIBUTION OF FEDERAL EMERGENCY FUNDS TO SUPPORT FOOD, AND SHELTER SUPPORT TO OTHER AGENCIES. UWMV RETAINS ONLY A 1% ADMINISTRATIVE FEE PER CONTY ALLOWING 99% OF ALL FUNDS TO GO DIRECTLY TO THE COMMUNITY.

FUNDED PARTNERS

UWMV'S COMMUNITY INVESTMENT PROCESS SUPPORTED 27 LOCAL PROGRAMS UNDER THE PILLARS OF FINANCIAL STABILITY, HEALTH & WELLNESS, AND EDUCATION. THESE PROGRAMS STRENTHENED THE SAFETY NET ACROSS THE MOHAWK VALLEY PROVIDING FOOD TO FAMILIES, HOUSING TO THOSE IN NEED, MENTORING TO YOUTH, LEGAL SERVICES, EMPLOYMENT SUPPORT TO RESIDENTS SEEKING A FRESH START, AND MEDICAL SERVICES. EACH FUNDED PARTNER REPRESENTS A PARTNERSHIP ROOTED IN TRUST, COLLABORATION, AND SHARED COMMITMENT TO IMPROVING LIVES. TOGEHTER, THESE PROGRAMS FORM A NETWORK OF CARE THAT ENSURES HELP IS ALWAYS WITHIN REACH.

- EVOLVE OUR RIDE UNITED PROGRAM THROUGH SUBSCRIPTION PARTNERSHIPS THAT PROVIDE RELIABLE TRANSPORTATION FOR EMPLOYEES AND CLIENTS.
- DEEPEN COLLABORATION WITH LOCAL SCHOOLS, NONPROFITS, AND BUSINESSES TO BUILD LONG-TERM STABILITY FOR FAMILIES ACROSS ONEIDA AND HERKIMER COUNTIES.
